## Assignments

**Reading from *A Theology for the Church*:** Each student is expected to read pages vii-544 and 604-685 of *A Theology for the Church*. A simple report of reading will be submitted at the end of the semester. **(500 pts.)**

**Weekly quizzes** will be limited to vocabulary, identification of key people, and memory verses. The study guides for each quiz will be available on blackboard one week in advance of the quiz. The quizzes will be taken via blackboard. Each quiz will be “active” for 7 days beginning on Monday morning. The allotted time, once started is fifteen (15) minutes. **Never use the back button** or the test will end and you will be graded on what you have completed. Only the top ten quiz grades will be averaged for your grade. Each quiz is worth 50 pts. **(500 pts.)**

**Theological discussions** help students to integrate biblical and historical data into systematic, contemporary, and practical expressions.

**Research papers** will be assigned for submission to the blackboard discussion board. These papers require students to research, reflect, and respond critically and coherently. Additionally the submitted paper becomes the basis for class discussion.

Class members will be assigned “slots” to present research papers on blackboard during the orientation week at the beginning of the semester. The assignments will be random by random drawing (the five(5) topics are assigned a number 1-5 and the number enrolled in the class will be divided by 5. If there are 30 enrolled students there will be 6 x 1s, 6 X 2s, etc. The class roll will be accessed in a random way. When your name is “up,” a numbered slip will be drawn. These assignments will be communicated to the class in an email to the address this syllabus is sent. The name and email address of each person will be listed beside the topic assigned. This is not to permit collaboration on research each student will work separately and is expected to have a unique non-plagiarized work. The email is provided to allow a season of “horse trading”. If you have a deep desire for a subject or need to present a time other than your assigned time, you and you alone have responsibility to persuade the student owning “the desire of your heart.” If you are able to trade, amiably, the two students must register the swap by each sending an email to the professor of record and copying the other student. On the Friday of the week following orientation week, that is the second Friday of the semester all assignments are set. Papers are to be submitted by means of the digital drop box **and** email to the professor of record by 12 noon on the date specified. The professor will review the submission and may post a personal post along with the student’s submission which will also be used in the ensuing discussion.

Topics for these research papers are:

1. Explore the relationship between the character of the God of the Bible as revealed in general and special revelation especially the Bible.
2. The Triune God who is both one and three. Explore the common characteristics of God as expressed in the Bible and Christian thought. Discuss the various ways unity and threeness make the revelation of God in the Bible unique.
3. Examine God’s role as creator, the nature and essential quality of His creation, and His providential care for it
4. Discuss and explore Human constitution, purpose and destiny as creature, created in the likeness and image of God.
5. Discuss the nature and consequences of Adamic Sin and personal human sins and relate this discussion to the necessity of a savior in the sovereignty of God.

**Failure to submit the paper as assigned on the date assigned will result in a failing grade in the course. No excuses. This is a central part of our becoming a theological community and accountability is crucial. (900 pts.)**

**Participation in all 12 discussion forums** will be one of the primary means for us to express our growth as a theological community this semester. In addition to the 10 student led discussion forums there

will be two necessary but not critically graded forums: a personal forum (which will be the means of introduction to each other, communication of prayer concerns and struggles.) and secondly, a general discussion forum which will give professors, teaching assistant, and students opportunity to post any additional articles and provide a feedback to the lectures, power points, and so on. **(Participation in these two forums is required. 100 pts of the final grade is credited for participation.)**

The ten student-led discussion forums require studied, researched and documented response from each student. In addition to responding to the original papers which open each forum, students are expected to read all other student postings in each forum and **respond with substance** to approximately 1/3 of the other postings. This part of participation in discussion will be graded 14 days after the forum is opened. **Each forum will restrict posting to a period of 2 weeks.** If additional, not-for-grade discussion is desired the student may open a thread in the general discussion. **(1000 pts.)**

Documentation of papers and responses within the discussion forums will be in accord with the current NOBTS style sheet. An example of proper usage and style is found in the course documents.

Students will take great care in responding to papers and other student postings on the discussion board. These exchanges are formal and civil. At no time will any person employ personal attacks, innuendos or sarcasm will be tolerated. Discussions are expected to be intense but on the issues of theology not personality or even style.
