Also REQUIRED for the Bachelor of Arts in Christian Ministry Degree:

- + Research and Writing—Course is provided through Academic Workshops on the New Orleans Campus and through CIV in the fall; successful completion of this course is prerequisite to enrolling in Senior Seminar
- + Senior Seminar—Course is provided yearly through Compressed Interactive Video from the New Orleans Campus, through Academic Workshops, and at the North Georgia Hub in the spring
- + Twelve (12) hours must be earned on the New Orleans Campus
- + One (1) Old Testament Interpretation course and one (1) New Testament Interpretation course must be earned through Leavell College, either at the New Orleans Campus or the North Georgia Hub
- + Students must earn a minimum of the last twenty-four (24) consecutive hours from Leavell College or request an exception from the Provost of NOBTS

\* Research and Writing & Senior Seminar are taught at NGA on Thursday nights: R&W from New Orleans via CIV in the fall and Senior Seminar in the spring
