Registration: Registration is done through the Leavell College office. Students may register as early as 90 days in advance. However, registration must be completed according to the scheduled deadline date for each workshop. Matriculation fees are required at the point of registration. Accounts do not have to be cleared for workshops, but students are required to pay course fees at registration unless other arrangements have been made through the Financial Aid Office. Tuition for Southern Baptist students is \$175 per semester hour. Tuition for non-Southern Baptist students is \$285 per semester hour. Tuition fees do not include meals or housing.
