## **Clery Reporting Information:**

The Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act is a federal law that requires colleges and universities to disclose information about crime on and around their campuses. The act is named in memory of Jeanne Clery, a 19-year-old Lehigh University freshman who was assaulted and murdered in her residence hall room on April 5, 1986.

### Mission Statement:

New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary's Office of Safety and Security desires all aspects of the campus be a safe and secure environment in support of the Seminary mission to equip leaders to fulfill the Great Commission.

### Office Information:

The Office of Campus Safety and Security reports to the vice president of business affairs and president of the seminary. The Campus Police department works closely with all departments of the Seminary to ensure that safety policy and procedures are uniformly executed and conveyed in a clear and consistent manner to all the Seminary's students, faculty, and staff.

An officer is located at the main entrance to the seminary 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. Uniformed Campus Police officers, a supervisor, and a director provide around-the-clock patrol and services to the seminary community. All Campus Police officers are licensed by the Special Officer division of the New Orleans Police Department. They have the same arrest powers as a New Orleans Police Department officer within the bounds of the Seminary jurisdiction.

Campus Police officers are responsible for a full range of safety services to the New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary community, including all crime report investigations, medical emergencies, fire emergencies, traffic accidents, and enforcement of all Seminary security and business related policies.

Campus Police officers submit incident reports for all crimes on campus reported to the department. These incident reports are filed with the New Orleans Police Department, District 3 and automatically become part of its record-keeping process. All serial numbers of vehicles and office equipment stolen from campus are reported through the 3rd District to the National Crime Information Center (NCIC).

All criminal activity, suspicious activity, and other emergencies on campus should be reported directly to the Office of Campus Safety and Security by any member or guest of the New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary community. Please dial (504) 944-7711 for all emergency or service calls, 24 hours a day. Campus Safety officers will meet you anywhere on campus to investigate and inquire about any of these events. Please call (504) 944-4455 for all nonemergency business calls.

## Campus Policies

### Definitions

#### Daily Crime Log

Campus Police maintains a daily crime log that lists all reported crimes. The log outlines the logistics of the crime (date, time, location), the nature of the crime, and how the crime was handled.

#### Crime Statistics

The Office of Campus Safety and Security gathers and compiles New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary's safety statistics. In addition to the violations reported to Campus Safety and Security, the director also solicits information from the Office of the Dean of Students. Crime statistics in this report from off-campus venues and adjacent streets were compiled in collaboration with the 3rd District, New Orleans Police Department.
