# **Reason 6: Fellowship**


# Fellowship

# Deadline For Application

- In order to be processed, all required documentation must be received at least 30 days before classes begin.

# Required Documentation

- Copy of all college transcripts for ***Masters'*** students (graduate programs); copy of any college transcripts or high school diploma for ***Leavell College*** students (undergraduate programs).
- Completed Health Certificate (but no immunizations for GA centers)
- Four Completed References
- \$25 application fee
