Position Description

We are inviting applications for multiple faculty positions (open fields) at the Assistant Professor or Associate Professor level, in a full-time or part-time capacity. The positions entail both academic leadership (up to 50%) and instructional responsibilities.

Carey Theological College is a highly team-based working environment. Faculty collaborates with both the Vice-President Academic and the College Academic Administrative team to strategize development plans for a specific ministry centre and to perform quality control on instruction at all levels to ensure Carey educational quality and accreditation standards.

Responsibilities

A. Administrative

- Oversee the operation and development of academic program(s) and/or a ministry centre. These include curriculum development, recruitment, marketing & communications, student learning assessment, strategic budgeting, acquisition of educational resources in collaboration with the College Academic Administrative Team and the development office.

- Develop strategic partnership opportunities with various constituencies.
- Maintain and develop church, alumni, and donor relations for the specific ministry centre.
- Form and hold regular meetings with working groups/committees for specific degrees or programs to discuss both academic and administrative concerns.
- Work with instructional faculty and other stakeholders to address questions or problems related to degree programs.

B. Instructional

- Develop and teach hybrid/online courses related to one's teaching fields, including one capstone/ contextual engagement project course.
- Make recommendation for the acquisition of online educational resources in consultation with other instructional faculty members.
