





### CHART 4: Age Range and Gender













#### CHART 6: Number of Dependents by Gender and Marital Status






### CHART 7B: Educational Debt Incurred at Seminary for All Students










# CHART 18: Importance of Field Education/Internship if Required





# **CHART 19: Effectiveness of Field Education in Developing Capacities**







### CHART 20: Level of Satisfaction with School's Services and Academic Resources






