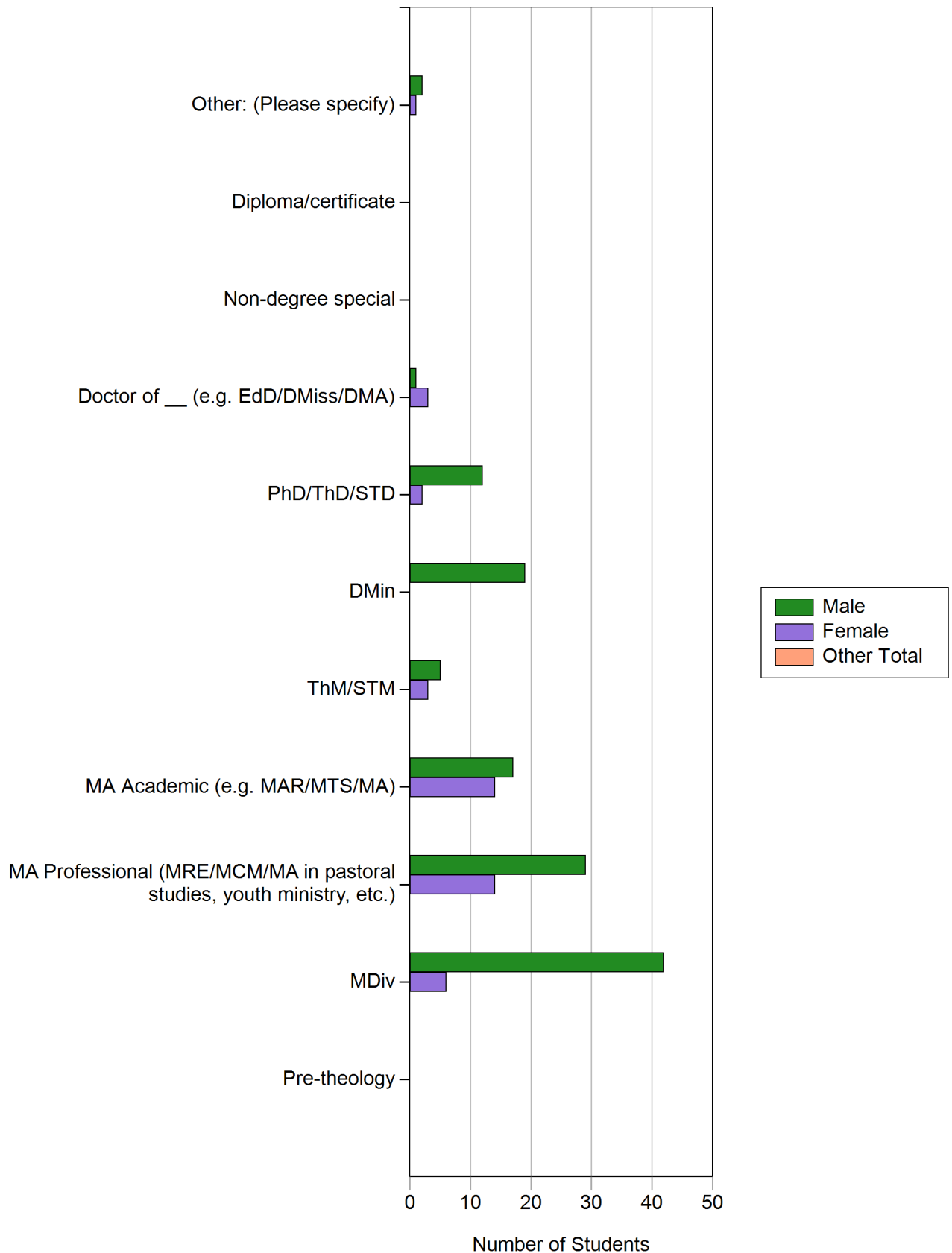

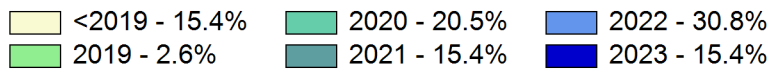
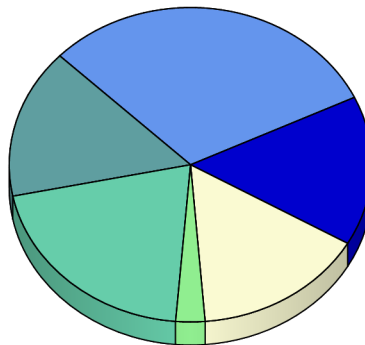


**CHART 2: Year Began Program**

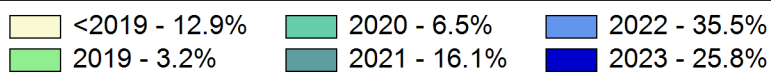
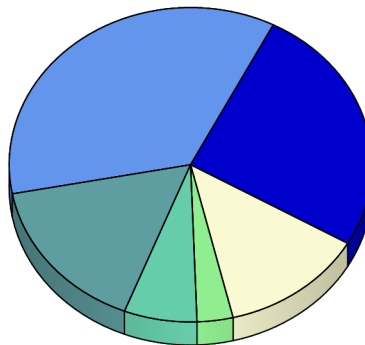

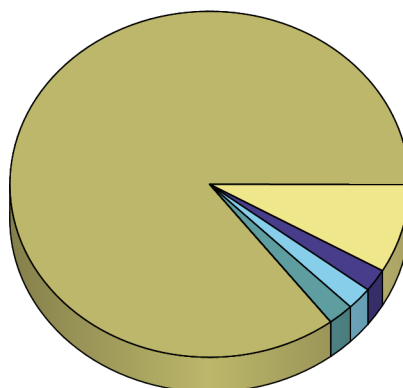

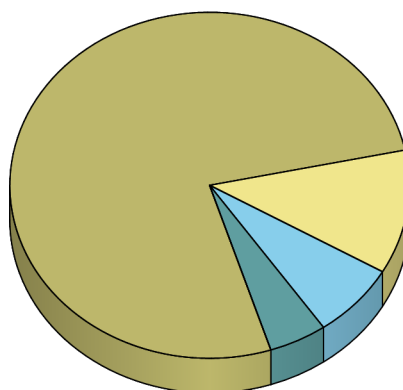
**CHART 3: Participants by Racial/Ethnic Identity**

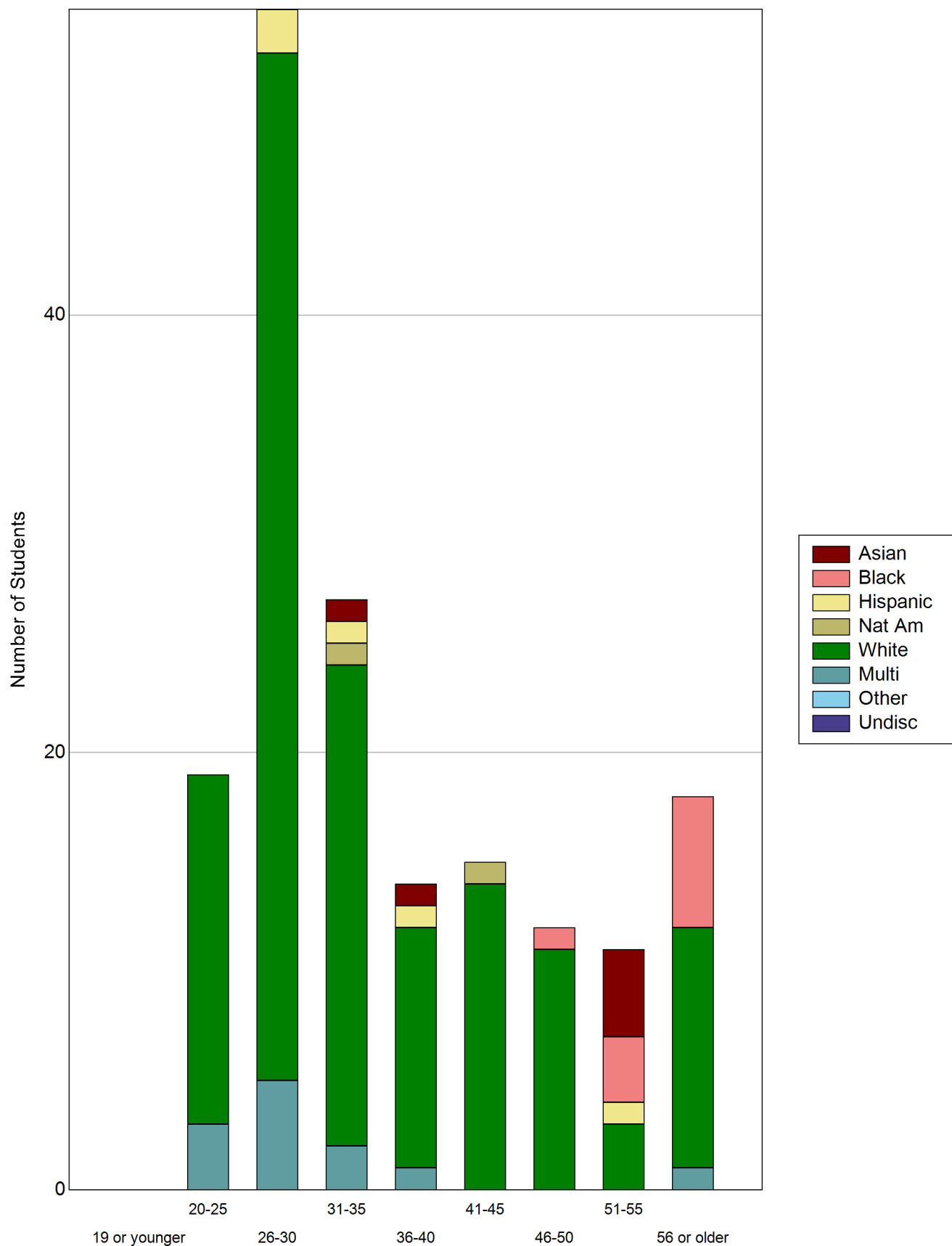

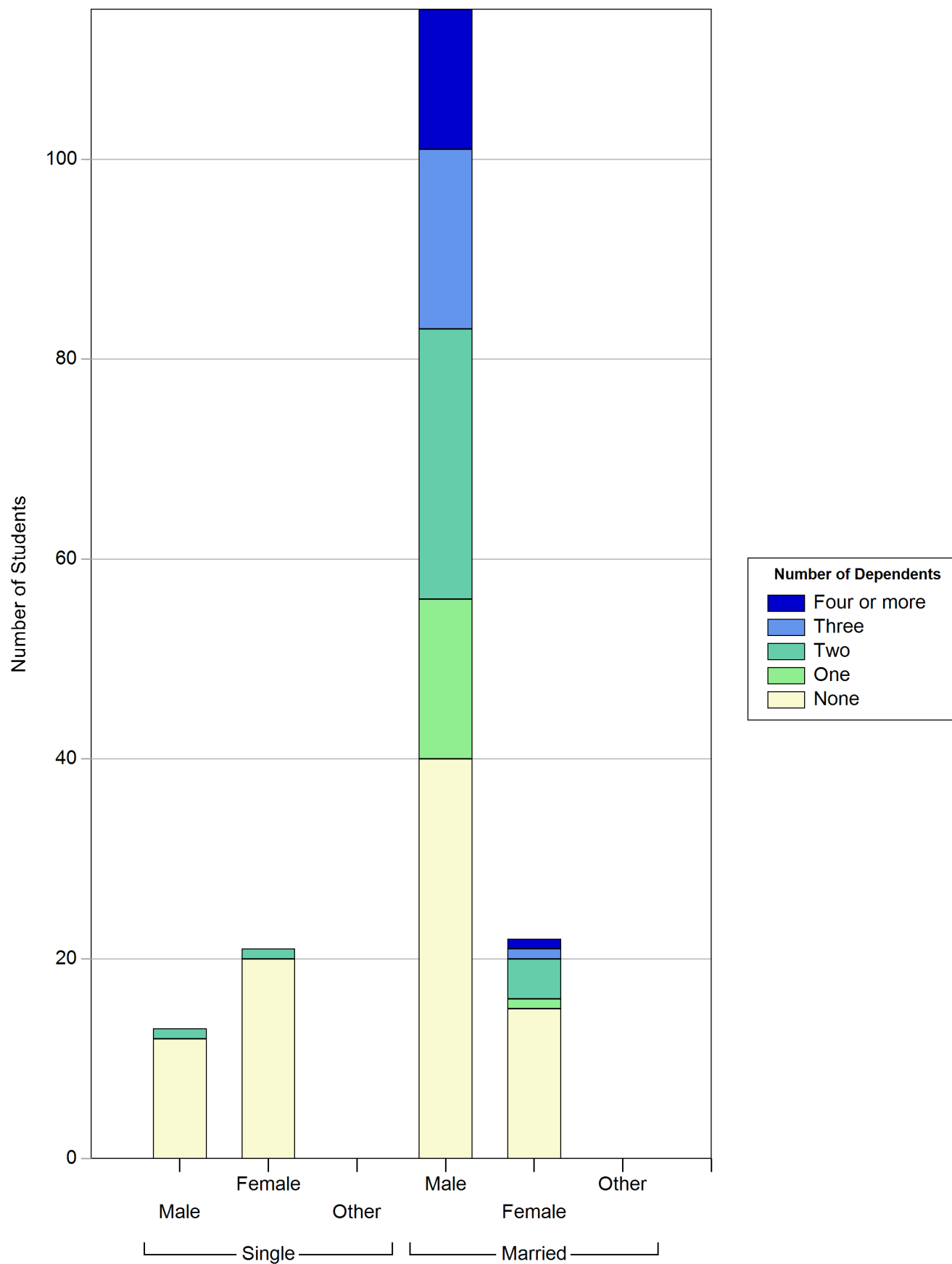

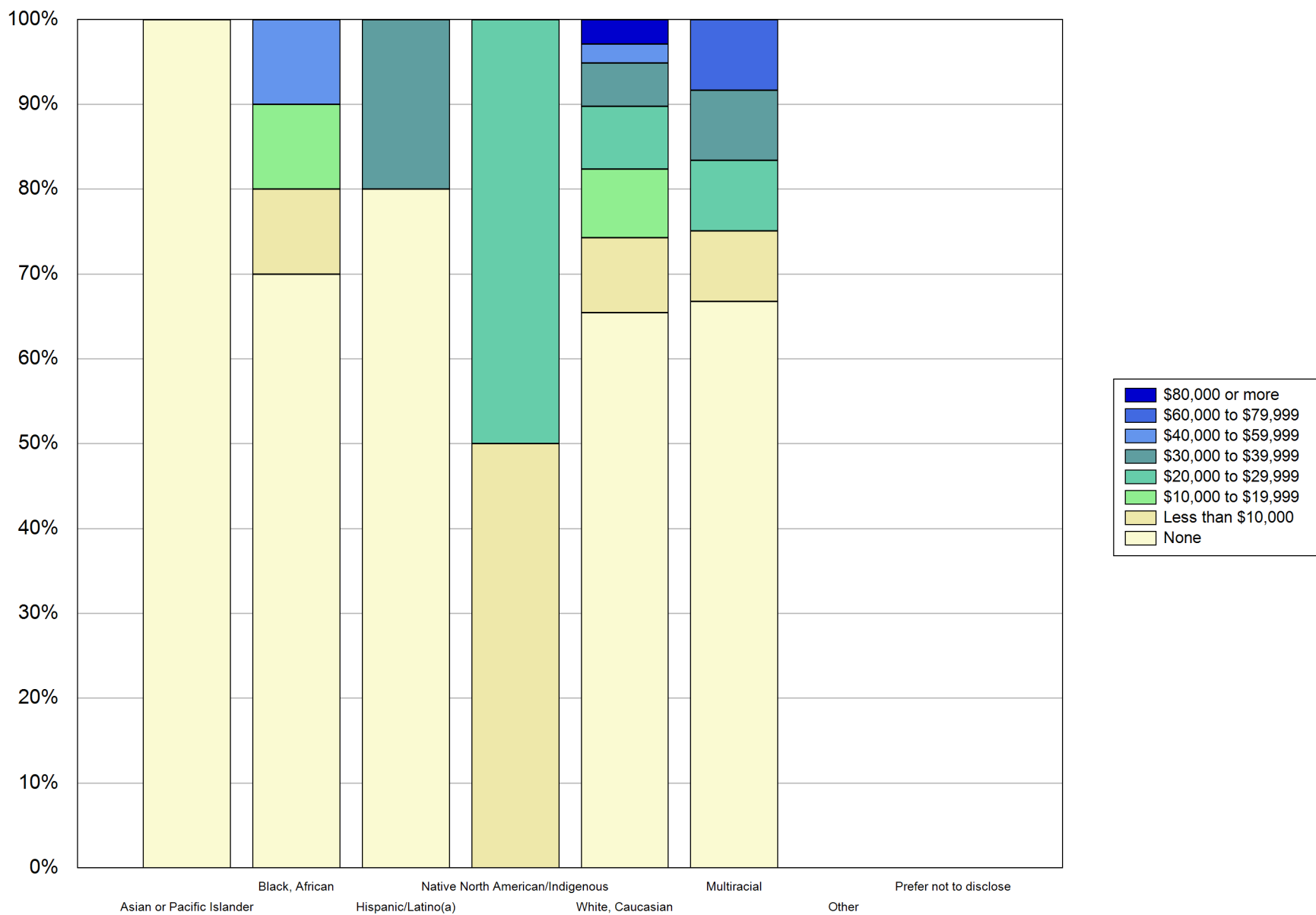

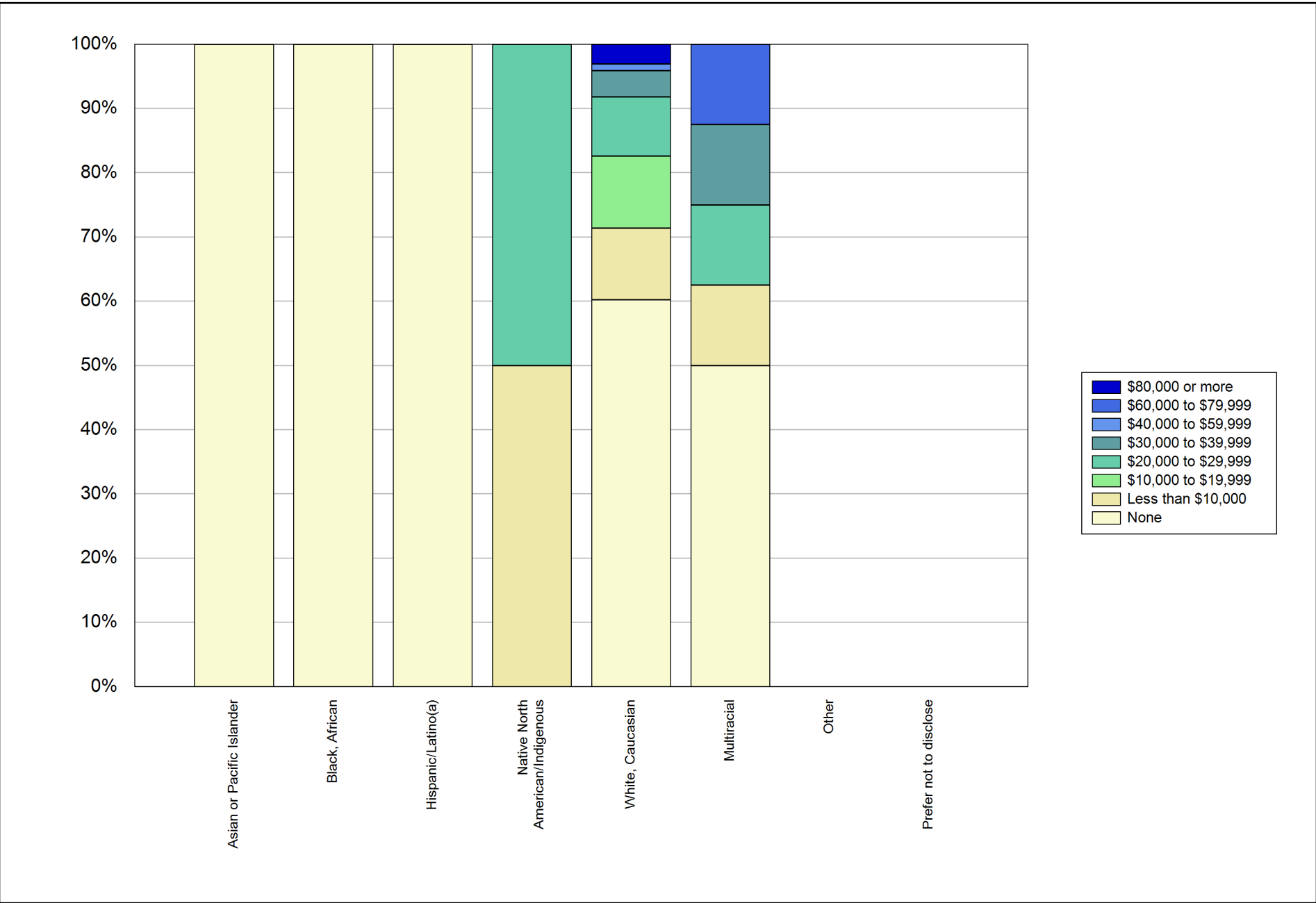

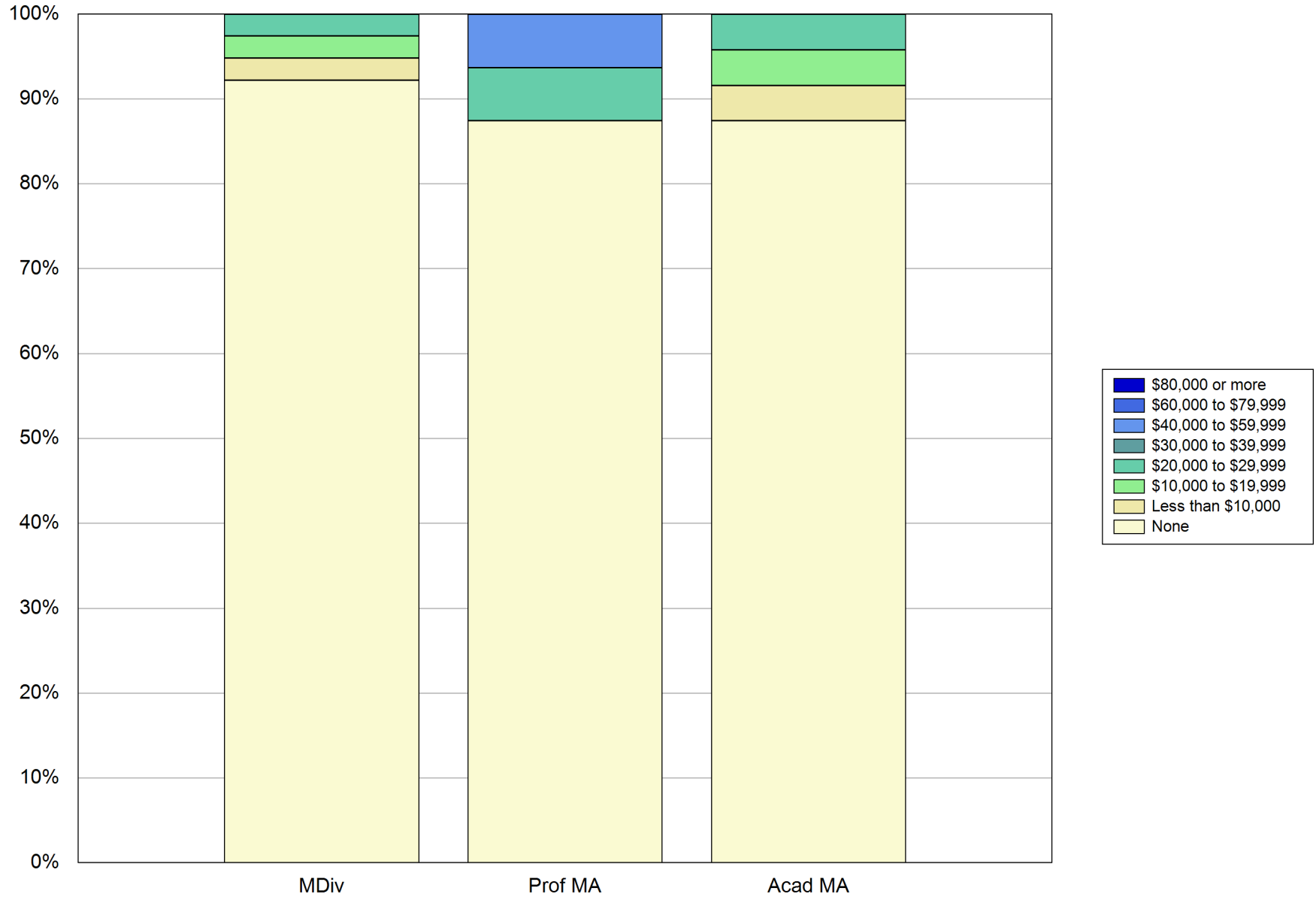

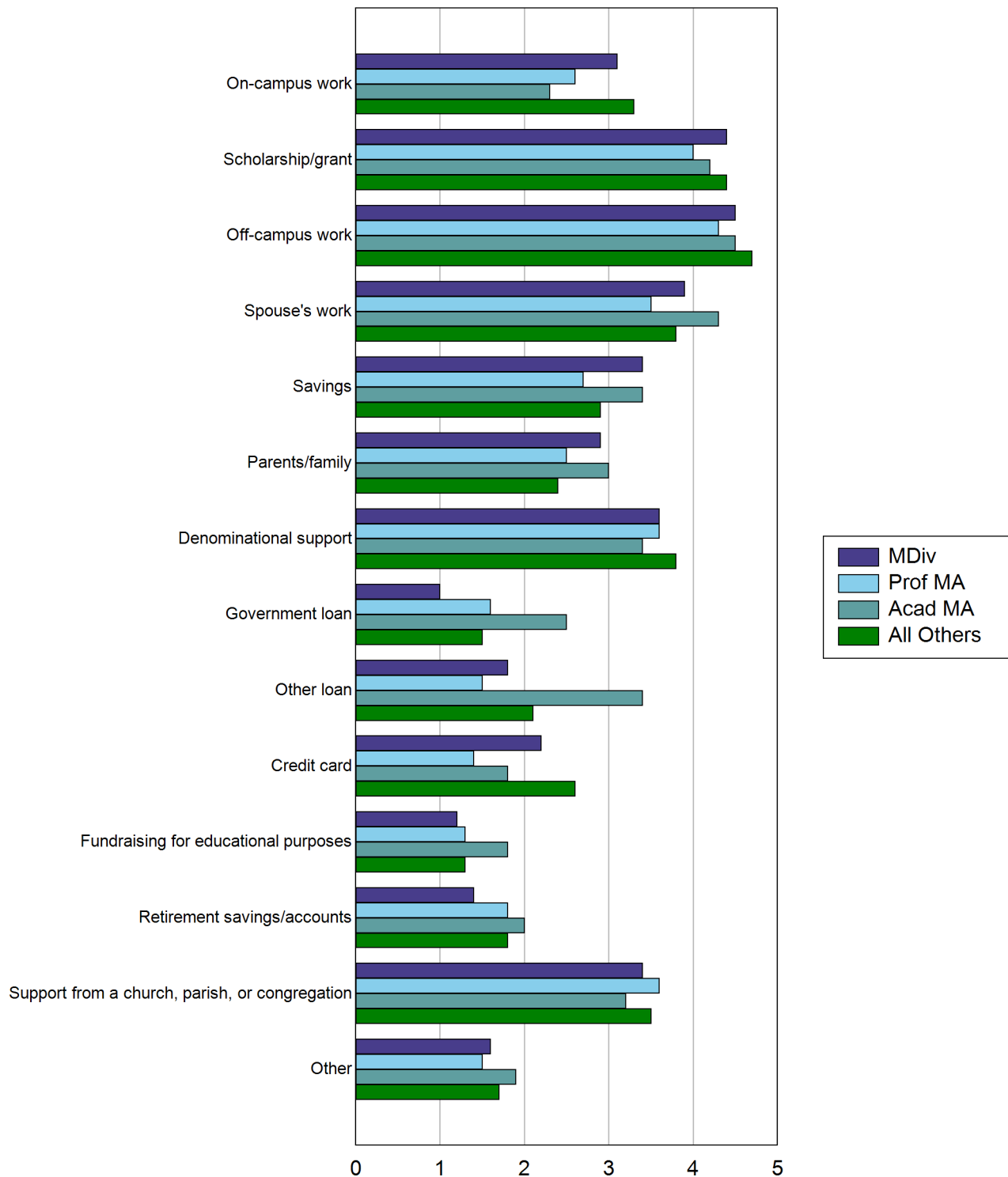

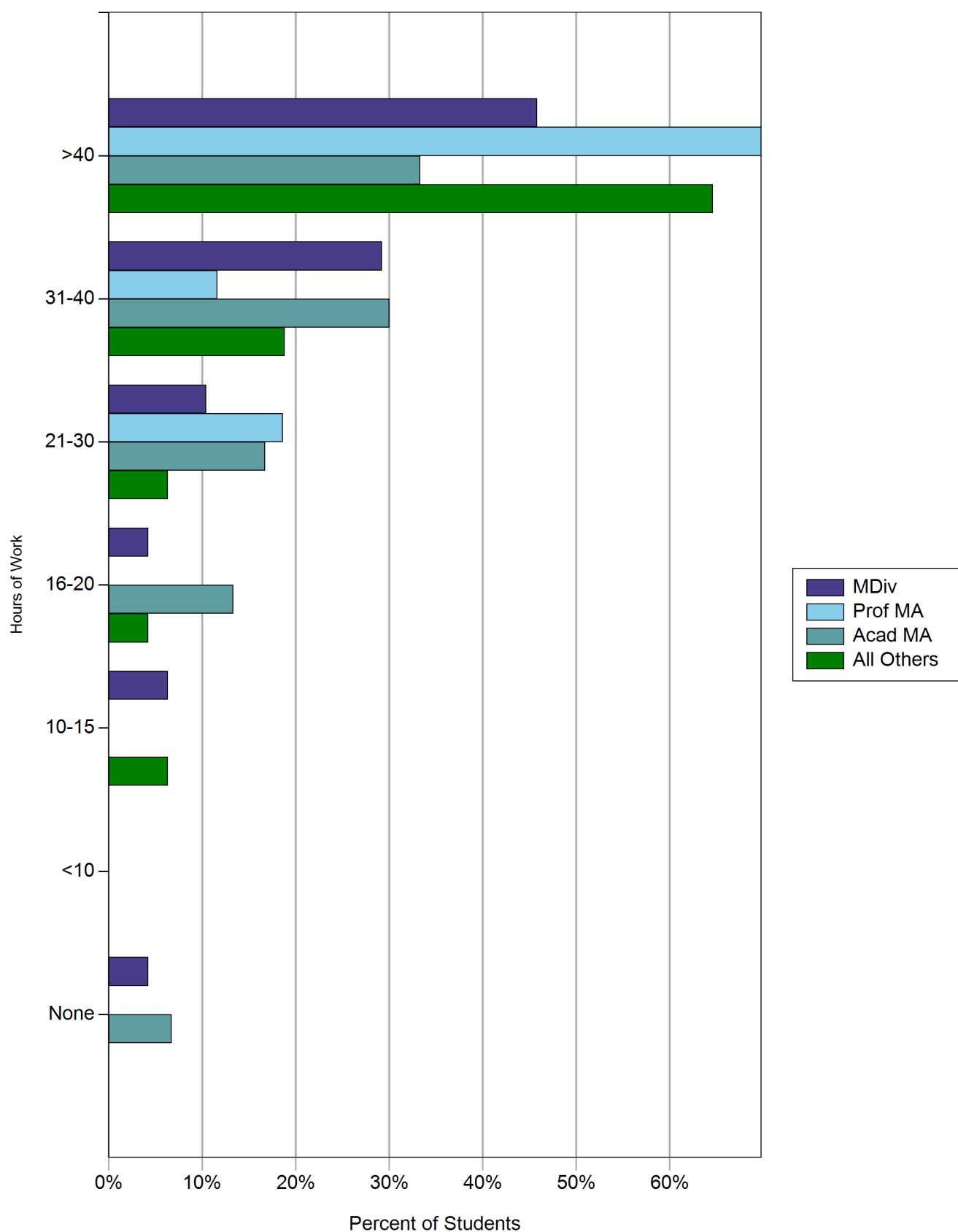

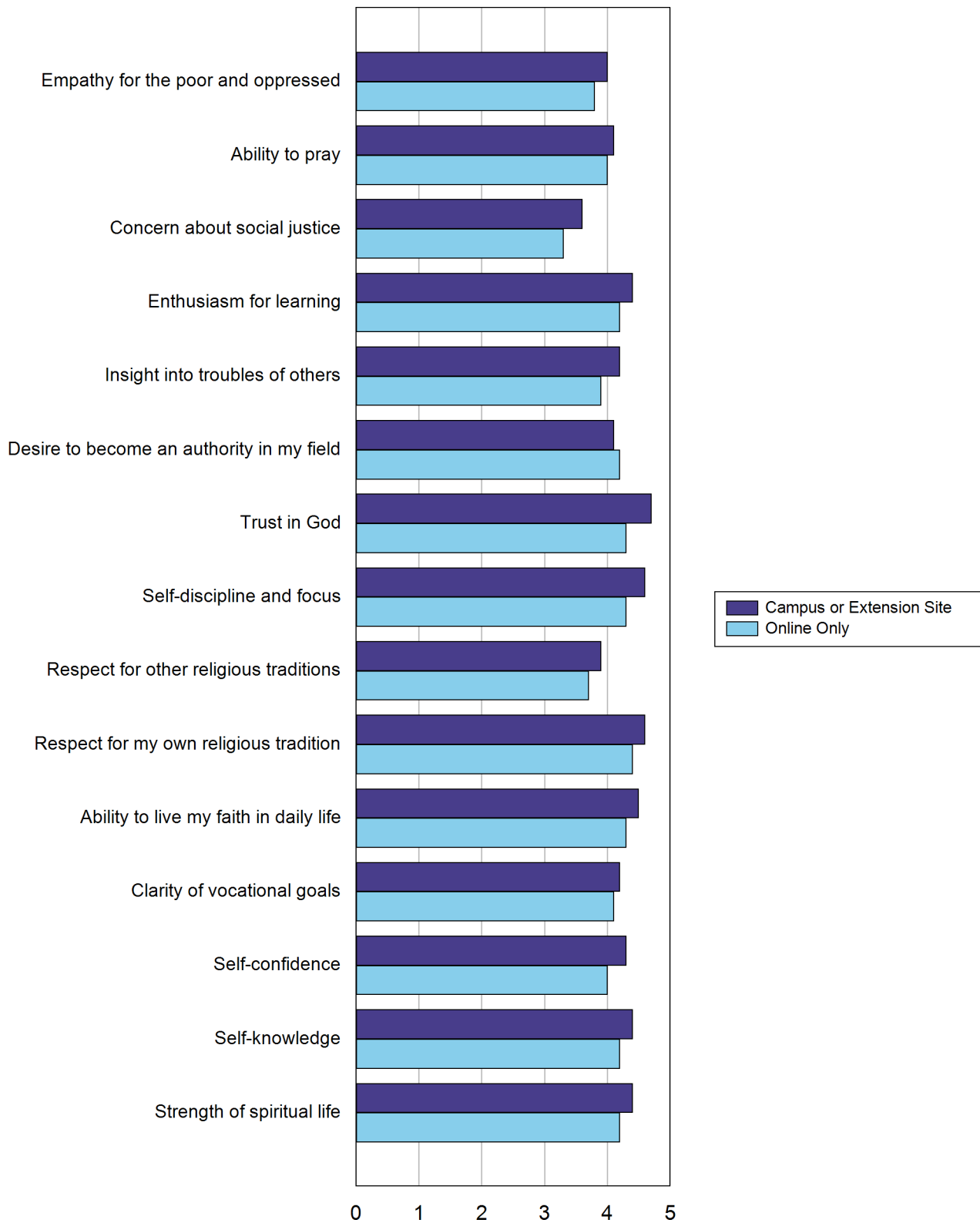

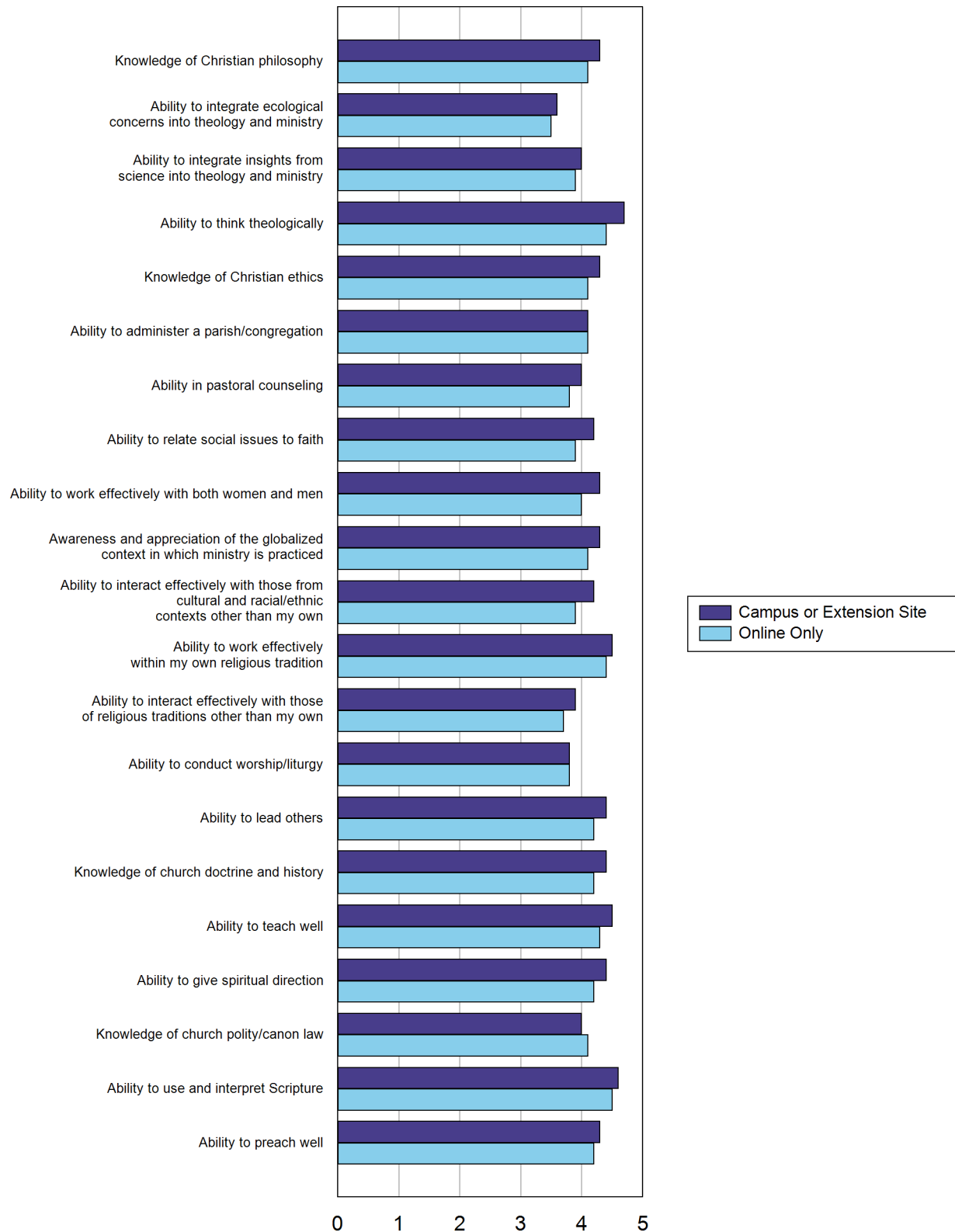

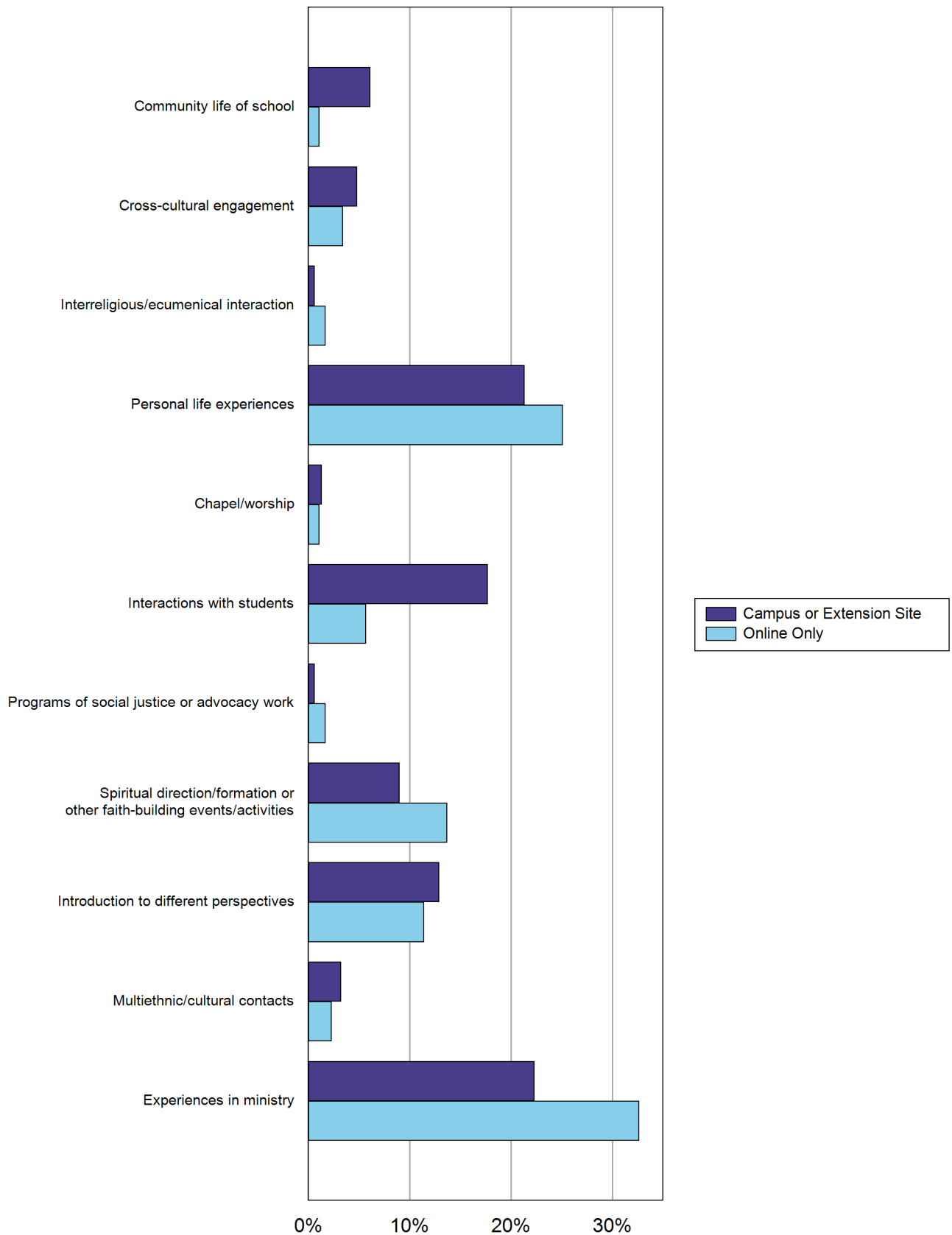

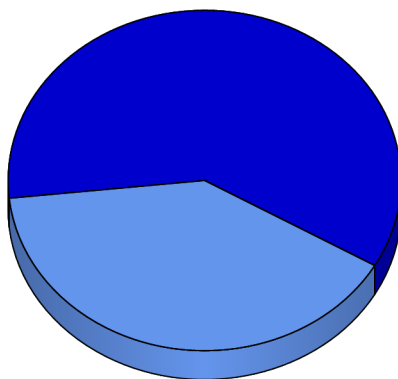

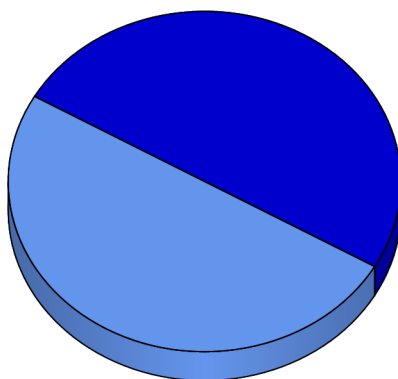
**CHART 18: Importance of Field Education/Internship if Required**

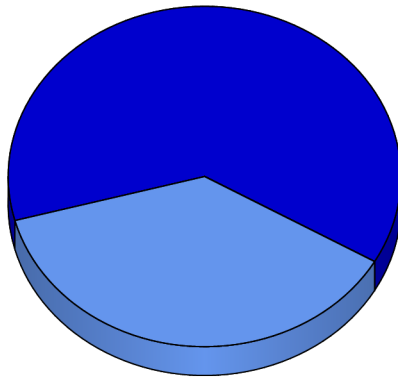

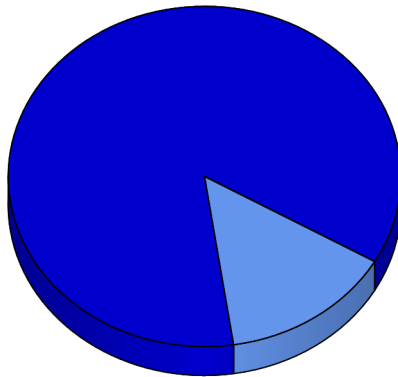

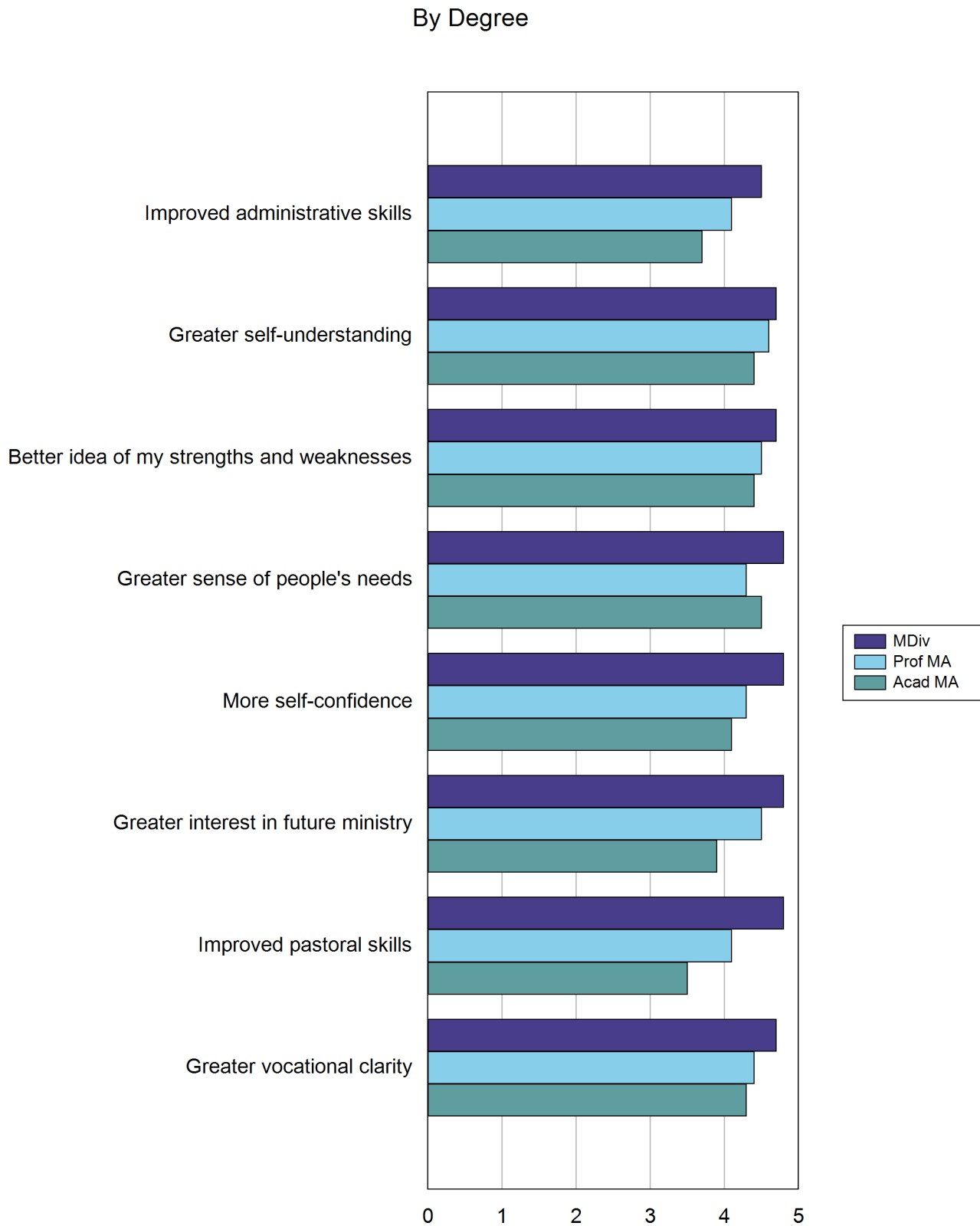

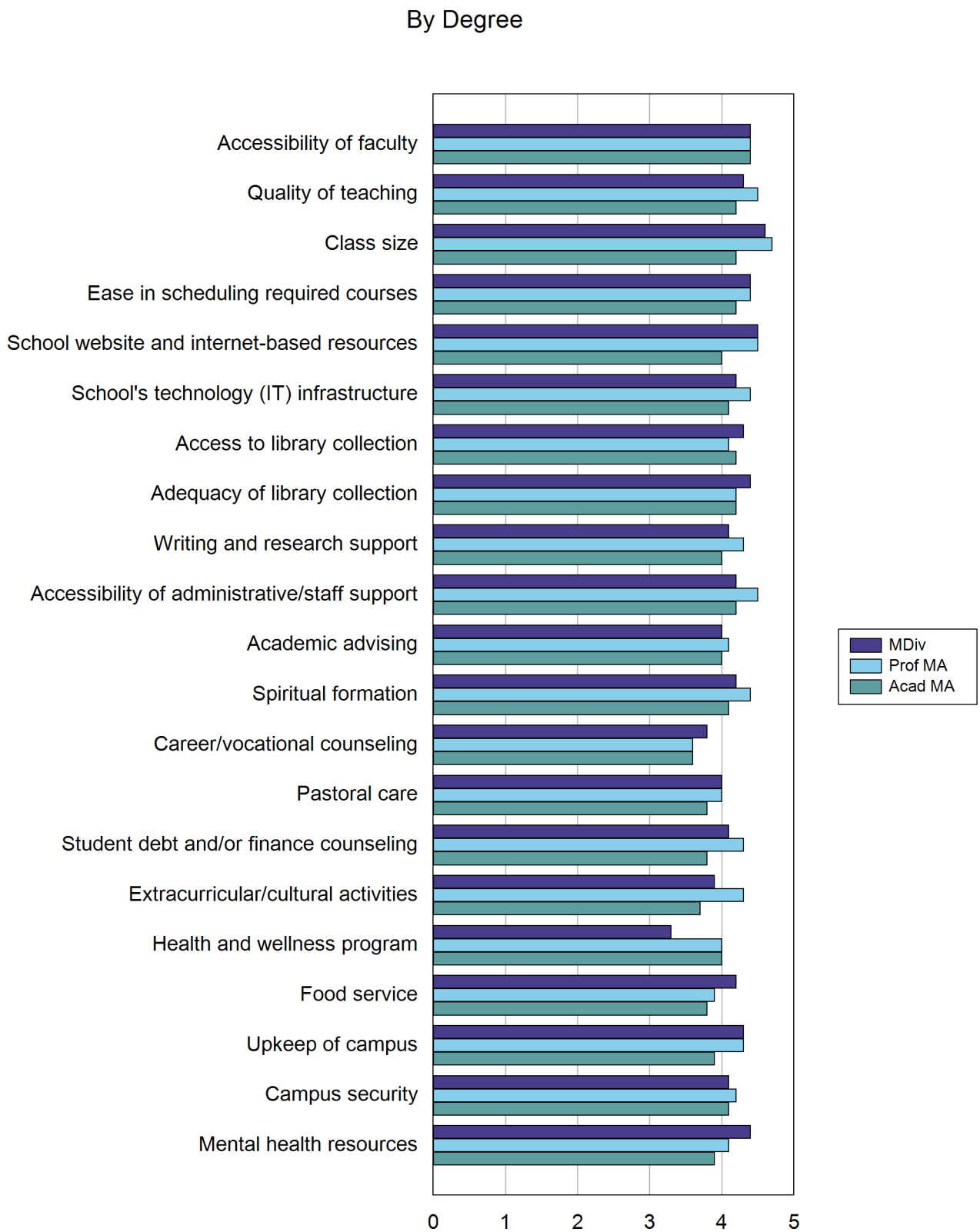

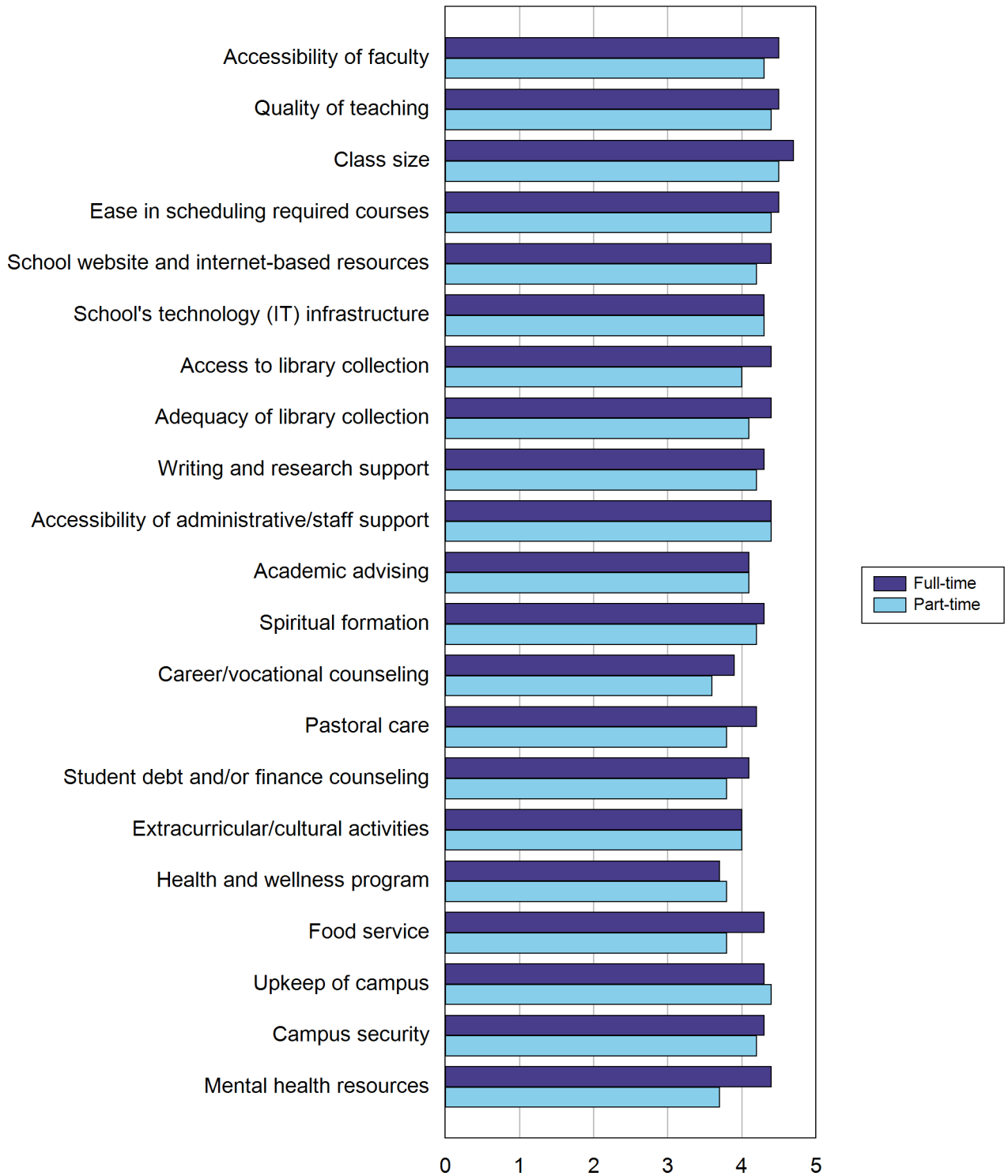

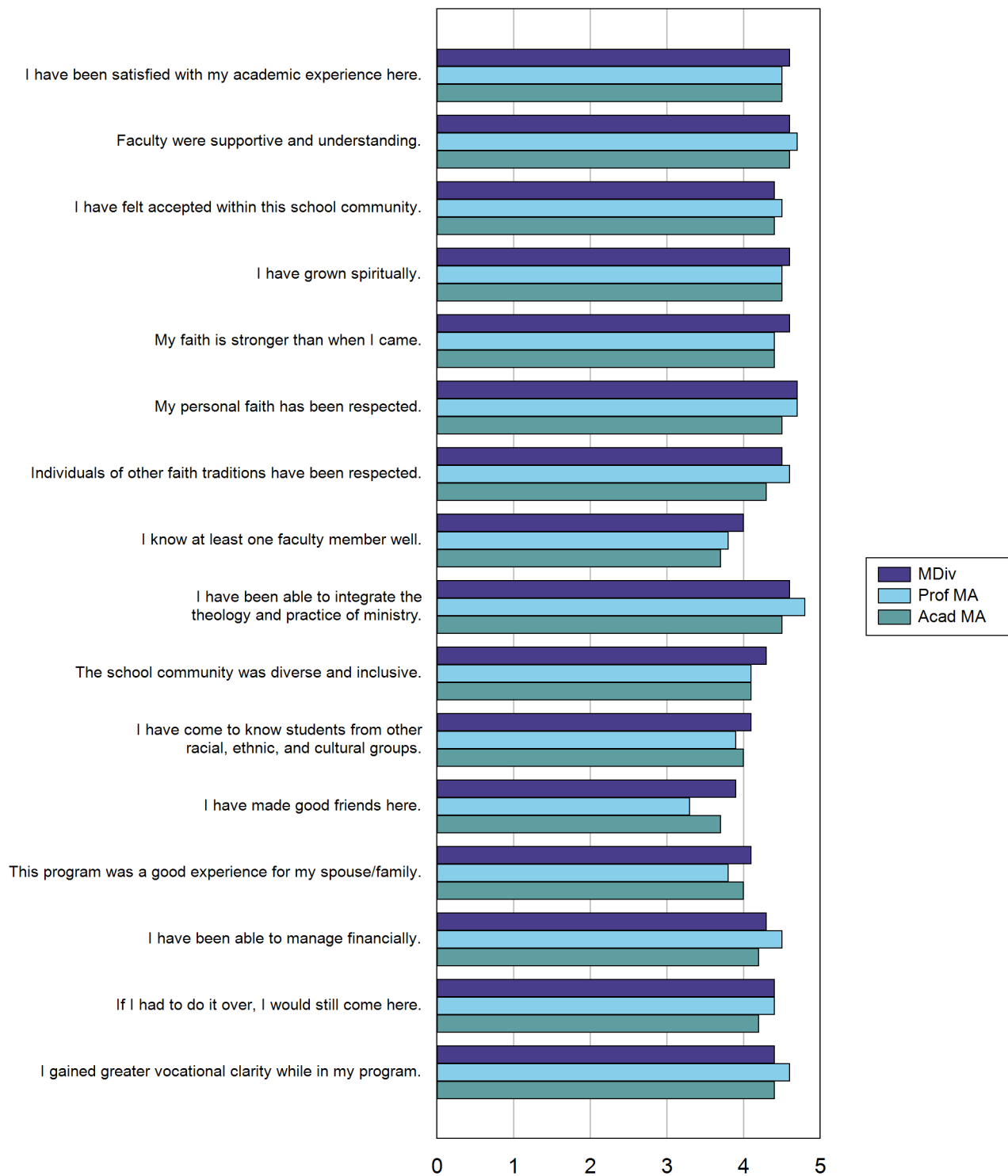

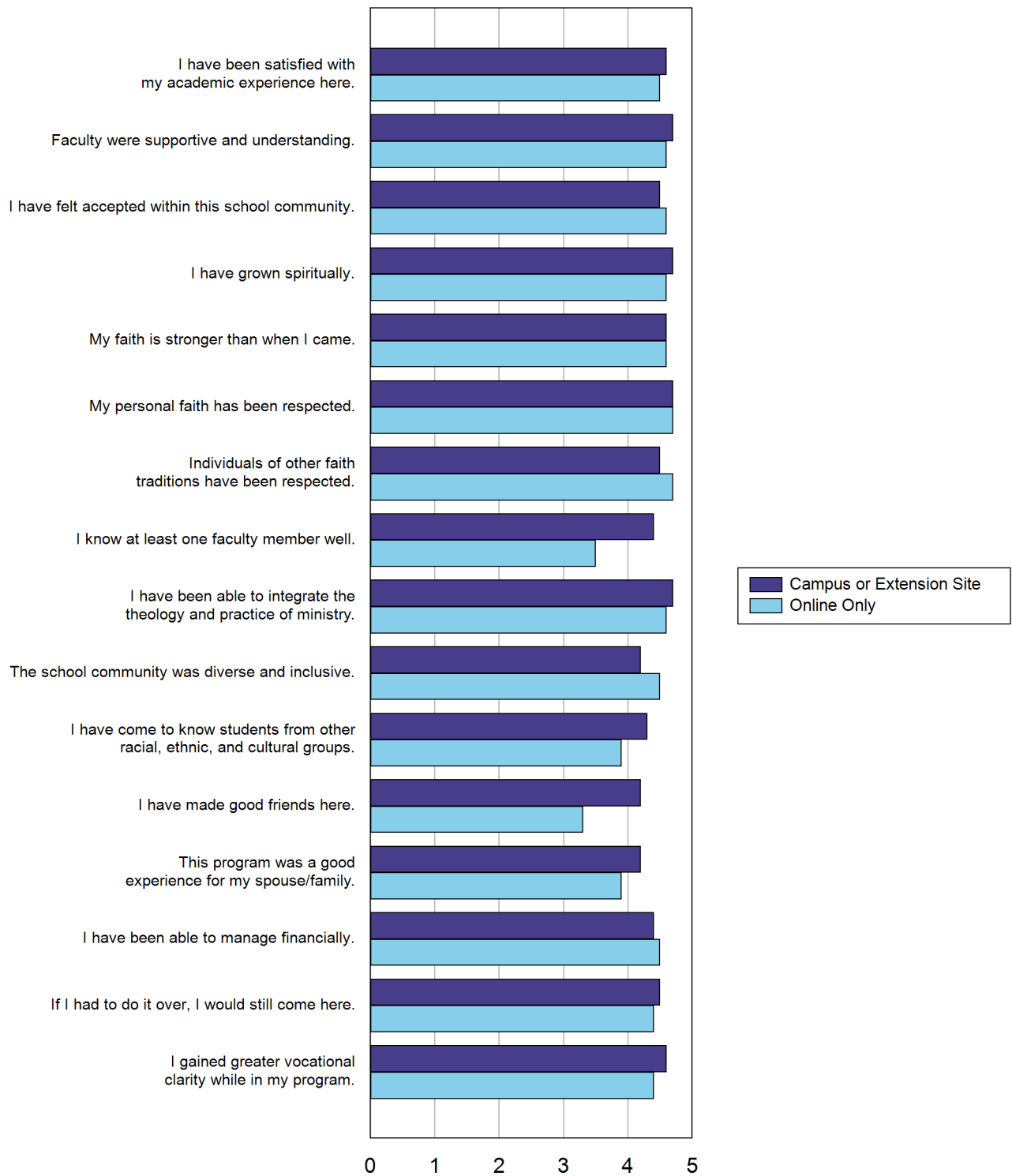
## CHART 21: Overall Experience during Theological Program

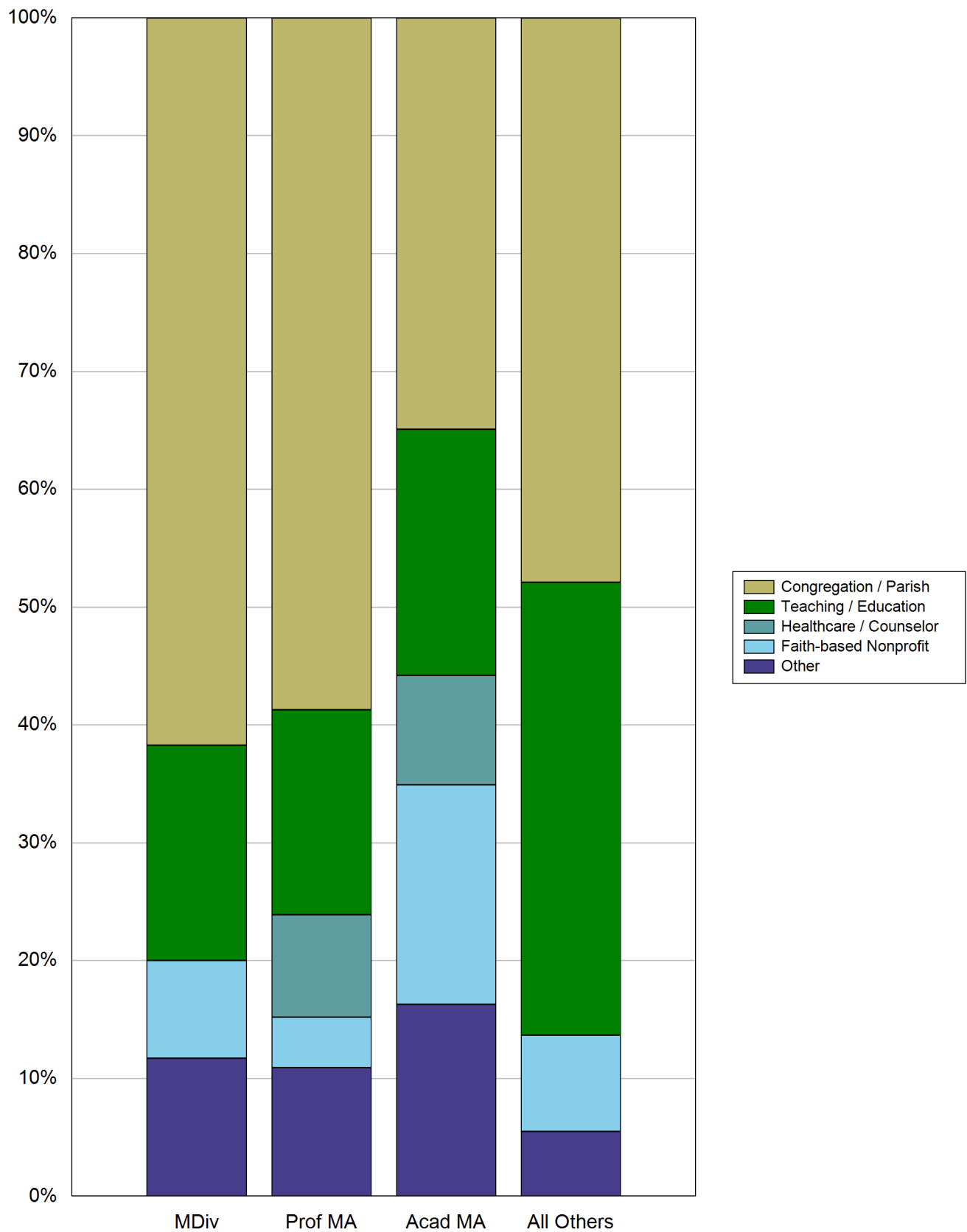
