		Summary/Reflection/Discussion:	
		Program Coordinator (Dr.	
		Doughty) noted a change in Leavell	
		College course schedule cycle	
		planning which made the Science	
		and Faith embedded assignment	
		less reliable than originally	
		intended. This course is now	

offered on a three-year intensive cycle, so Dr. Doughty recommended using <i>Doctrine of Humanity, Sin, and Suffering</i> instead. This course is offered on a two-year NO and FLEX cycle.
Dr. Wilton questioned why prison scores were considered since no students in those sections are in this program. Still, the Spring 2023 scores were low, so Dr. Doughty recommended following through on an unfulfilled intention of making Leavell College faculty available for SS research projects.

Executive Summary:

This is the first assessment of this major which was revised in 2023. Dr. Doughty expressed satisfaction with our first round of results and shared concerns from an earlier jury on objectives #1-2. Specific to Worldview & Apologetics, we hope to improve reliability of data by assessing a different required course in the major and improve competency of program students by providing faculty interaction with *Senior Seminar* students. Action plans should be acted on easily this calendar year, providing more data in the next full assessment. The data for the new embedded assignment in the program will be parallel to the existing assignment.
