

F-1 VISA Renewal Requirements

It is the student's responsibility to prepare accordingly for their visa renewal application. Visa renewal is only required if the student's visa has expired and they wish to leave and return to the U.S. before the program end date listed on their Form I-20. Students should plan accordingly and allow for plenty of time to renew their visa.

F-1 VISA Renewal Requirements

Step One: Complete new nonimmigrant visa application form (Form DS-160)

Step Two: Schedule an appointment at the student's U.S. Embassy or Consulate in their home country

Step Three: Gather all required documents

Form I-20 with up-to-date signature on the second page
All official transcripts from all schools attended in the United States
Course schedule for the next semester (not current semester)
Copies of proof of funding to verify the financial support shown on the student's Form I-20
Student Enrollment Verification letter dated the month they are departing
Current passport
Bank statements form all student sponsors (must be less than 30 days old)
Any other required documentation (student's responsibility to bring all necessary documents)

Step Four: Pay visa application fee

Step Five: Attend F-1 visa renewal interview

Step Six: Bring a copy of the new F-1 visa and Form I-94 to the P/DSO upon return to the United States
